
Attorney Mike Stebbins gave an overview of the Sunshine Law. He gave each Steering Committee member a summarization packet with some highlights of the Sunshine Manual. He explained that Steering Committee members should not communicate with one another regarding business that might come before the committee. Members are allowed to speak to SRIA staff, Attorney, Attorney General, or Commission on Ethics if there are any questions regarding Sunshine Law. Mr. Stebbins requested that Committee members retain any and all paperwork regarding the Steering Committee as they are public record. If the Committee member is unable to retain this documentation, they should return it to SRIA staff as records custodian.
