RE: Minutes of April 6, 2011 Palm Tree Sub - Committee Meeting

A Palm Tree Sub - Committee Meeting was held on Wednesday, April 6, 2011 at 11:30 a.m. Ms. Tammy Bohannon, Chairman, called the meeting to order.

Committee Members that were present are as follows:

Ms. Susan Hoover was not able to attend the meeting.

Also in attendance were Ms. Jayne Bell, SRIA Director of Administration and Mr. Jim Reeves.

Ms. Bohannon stated that the request for the additional Palm Tree plantings for the proposed R.V. Park on Via De Luna came before the SRIA Board and was approved subject to sign off by the Palm Tree Sub – Committee out of respect for the time and work that had done for the project.

Mr. Rinke stated that at the SRIA Committee meeting when the proposed R.V. Park was discussed, the SRIA Board members wanted great landscaping as a buffer for the park. He felt it would be worth spending a small portion of the palm tree beautification funds to augment the landscaping for Mr. Reeves and offered possibly 40 pindo palms.

Mr. Reeves stated that there were three aspects to the project that he wanted to specify and provide;

- 1) He said Pensacola Beach RV Resort would budget on a 2 for 1 basis, that is, if the "contributed" palm trees cost \$16,000.00, the RV Park would spend at least \$32,000.00 on landscaping the site with a special emphasis on the South line along Via de Luna (600 lineal feet) as requested by the SRIA.
- 2) The RV Park would agree to irrigate the "contributed" palm trees.
- 3) Because the unpaved portion of the right of way is not wide enough for the "contributed" palm trees, the RV Park is willing to allow the "contributed" palm trees to be planted on the RV Park property.

Mr. Reeves, Mr. Rinke and Ms. Bohannon wished to clarify that Mr. Reeves did not ask for free palm trees and verified that Mr. Rinke had approached Mr. Reeves about the palm trees.

Upon motion of Ms. Tammy Bohannon seconded by Ms. Gwen Fontenot, the Palm Tree Sub – Committee approved moving forward with Mr. Rinke's proposal for additional palm trees to help with the buffer for the proposed R.V. Park. (4-0)

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
