1- 5 A Special Board Meeting of the Santa Rosa Island Authority was held on Wednesday, August 25, 2010, beginning at 8:15 p.m. Members in attendance were: Dr. Thomas Campanella, Mr. Ed Guernsey, Mr. Fred Gant, Mr. Dave Pavlock, Mr. Vernon Prather and Ms. Tammy Bohannon, Chairwoman. Ms. Bohannon, Chairwoman, called the meeting to order.

Item # 2 - Adoption of the SRIA Budget FY 2010/2011(Staff report by Dottie Ford)

A brief discussion took place regarding the funding of sand testing by Dr. Richard Snyder, Director of Center for Environmental Diagnostics and Bioremediation, University of West Florida.

Mr. Prather asked staff to research the cost benefit to purchasing a front end loader as opposed to leasing it while moving forward with the capitol expense of acquisition.

**Upon motion of Mr. Dave Pavlock seconded by Mr. Vernon Prather, the Board unanimously approved adding a line item for sand testing to the University of West Florida in the amount of \$40,000.00. The payment will be made in two (2) equal installments of \$20,000.00 each (December 1, 2010 and April 1, 2011). Under the same motion the Board unanimously adopted the FY 2010/2011 Budget as amended. (6-0)**
