RE: Required lease assignment transfer on Pensacola Beach

As a reminder, upon the sale/purchase of leased property on the Island, the SRIA requires a copy of the <u>recorded assignment of lease</u> in order to transfer the property, and change our records to reflect the new leaseholder. Also, be reminded that a lease fee is assessed that is based on the individual lease agreement and each agreement can be quite different.

We ask that you keep this information in mind as you take part in any way in the sale/purchase of leased property on Pensacola Beach, whether as the sales agent, closing agent, or new leaseholder. Please assist us in making sure that we have the proper documents to allow the SRIA to maintain current lease records, and disseminate important information, including billing, storm related materials, and process new construction projects being applied for as the new leaseholder
